Project Description: This project will construct the Second Phase of the Slavic Village Downtown Connector, which includes the North and Morgana Run and Booth Avenue Extension trail projects totaling approximately 2.7 miles.

Grantees will receive a partially prepopulated draft from the RAISE Program Office within the next month, but are welcome to begin reviewing the template. The Department expects all RAISE funding to be obligated no later than September 30, 2028 and expended by September 30, 2033.

The USDOT Operating Administration (e.g. FAA, FHWA, FRA, MARAD, FTA) overseeing your project will contact you in the coming weeks regarding next steps to complete the relevant requirements before executing a grant agreement.

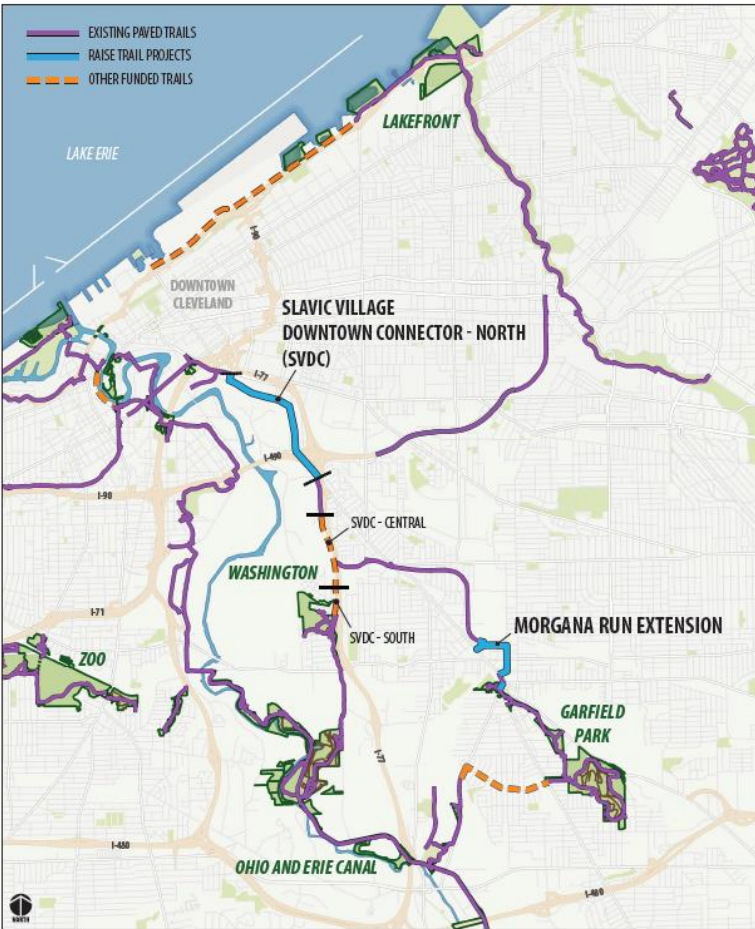

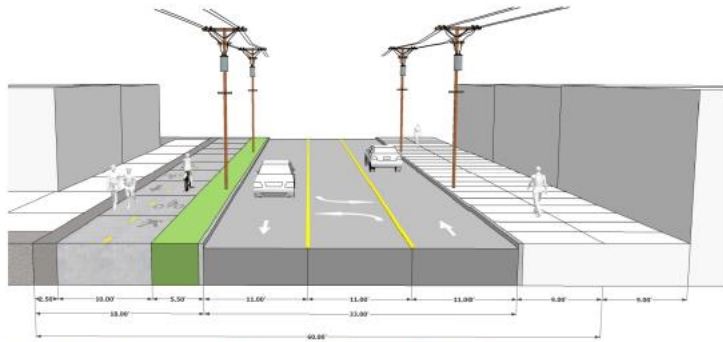


Figure 10: Broadway Avenue Road Diet - Option 1 - Looking South

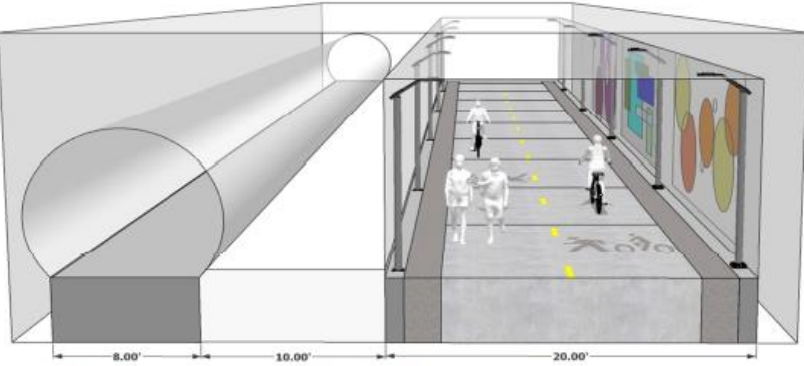


Figure 13: Booth Avenue Underpass Proposed Section View

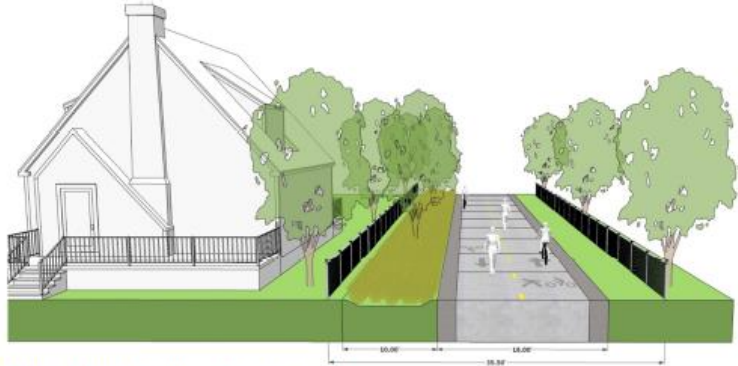
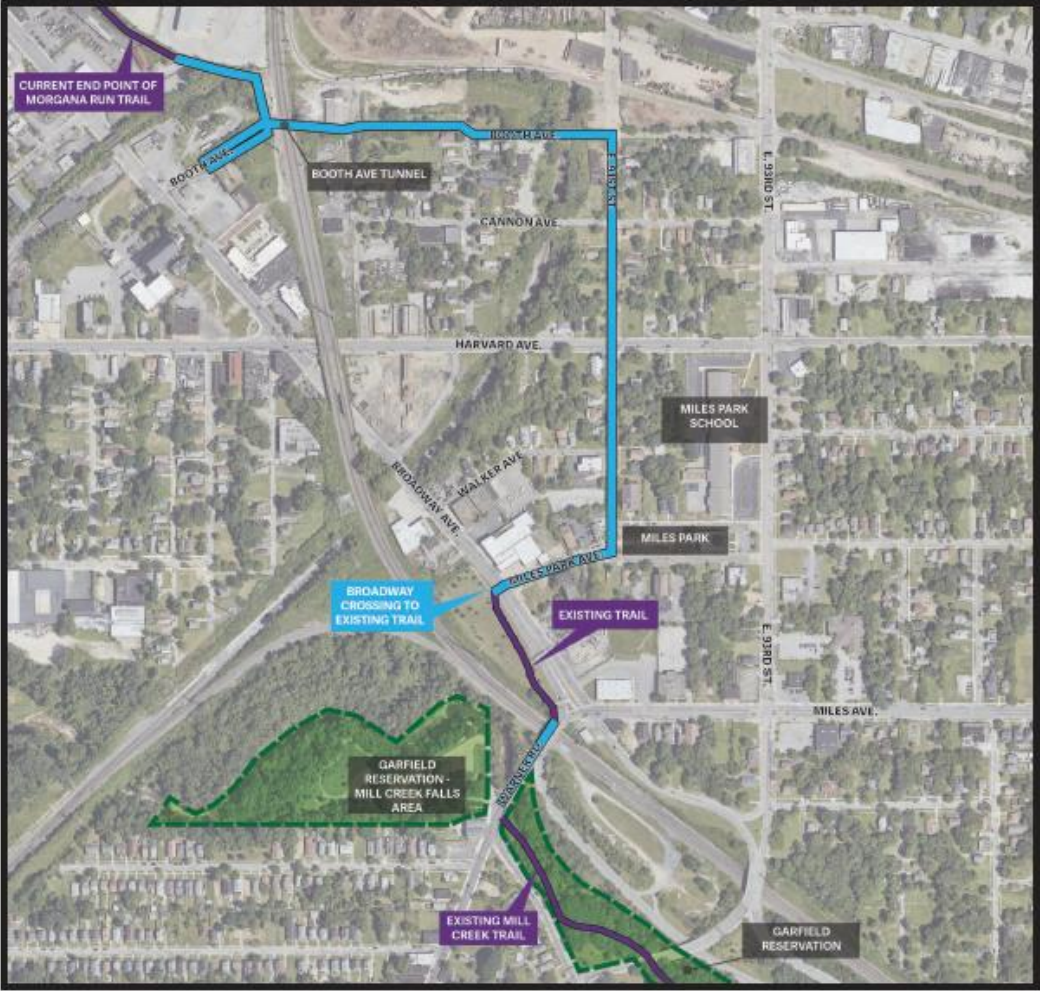


Figure 8: Booth Avenue Closed Section View
